## New Local rule:

### 3a New Tree Plantations

Staked, tubed or wired trees are no play zones and if they interfere with the lie of the ball, stance, area of intended swing or the line of play relief must be taken.

#### Players may

Either : drop without penalty under Rule 16 1b within one club length of nearest point of relief within the penalty area and not nearer the hole

Or : Take relief from the penalty area with penalty of 1 stroke.

Penalty for breaking rule : Strokeplay General Penalty, Match play Loss of hole "

We took delivery of our new Weidenmann GXi8 Terra spike machine this week. This is a modern high speed Verti Drain used to relieve compaction and help with surface water and rooting on the greens. This is a big investment for the club and the Greens team would like to thank the board and members for their continued

support.

The grass continues to grow but very slowly, which is why we have delayed any scaryfying, verti cutting and feeding - once the soil temperatures rise we will continue with this work.

Its great to welcome Drew Dunn back to the crew as a volunteer, he has already been out on the fairways and we have no doubt that you will bump into him on your way round.
